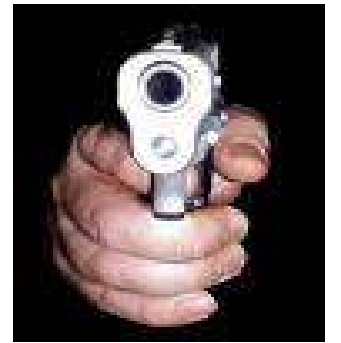

How did you do? Did you get them all?

Whenever the sin of those who love darkness is revealed, the reaction is the same. The messenger is shot, because the revealing news he or she brings is not welcome. Prophets are always opposed and persecuted, and sometimes they are killed. The same reaction is even present to a lesser degree amongst those who walk in the light. Sometimes we get too comfortable in our usual ways of doing things and with our inherited patterns of thought, so that we do not like anyone to challenge us to think anew or to look at things from a different perspective. An open investigation in the "light" is sometimes prevented by the kneejerk accusation: "That's liberal" or "That's _____" (fill in the blank as appropriate).

It is for this reason that many people rejected Jesus when he appeared in this world, because they were expecting someone different. Some of those who opposed Jesus were doing so from the best of intentions. They thought that they were preserving truth against his innovative error. They refused to admit that their reasoning and cherished positions might be wrong. Therefore, they never gave Jesus a fair hearing.

Part of what it means to be one who "lives by the truth" is to have a willingness to put things to the test, to question, to ask, and to have an open mind. One who "lives by the truth" is not afraid of honest investigation, because that person is not afraid of the "light."
