It was the closing minutes of an extremely close football game between two great rivals. One team was only down by seven points but successfully driving the ball down the field, only to have a pass intercepted by the defender and returned for a touchdown, taking away any hopes of coming back. A particularly irate fan yelled at the quarterback, "What are you doing? Are you playing for the other team?"

How did you do? Did you get them all?

Just as the quarterback unintentionally threw the ball to the wrong player, we too, can do things by our actions, words, and behavior that are not pleasing to God. Such ungodliness in our lives, although seemingly harmless or accepted by the world, is switching sides and playing for the other team. A child of God is not one who wants to see how much they can imitate the world; rather they are concerned about how much they can imitate the example of Jesus Christ, and doing such things so that the world will know for which side they are playing.

Do you want to be on the winning side? Sure, we all do. The outcome has already been revealed, the winner is known. Only those who are found on the Lord’s side will have the victory (Rev 21:7). So for what team are you playing? Don’t allow Satan to deceive you into thinking you are serving the right team when in actuality you are serving him. You may deceive the rest of the world, and even yourself, but you cannot deceive God, “The Lord knoweth them that are His” (II Tim 2:19; cf. Matt 25:31-33). As Joshua said long ago, “choose you this day whom ye will serve...but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD” (Josh 24:15).
