The other day, I was working at my desk on a lesson. When I turned my chair to retrieve a book from behind me, my chair would not roll very well. I worked with my chair, wondering what could possibly be the problem, when from under one of the wheels came a small pebble. It amazed me how just one small pebble that I carried in from outside could so greatly hinder my chair from rolling freely.

Then I saw the spiritual application. Sin in our lives does the same thing. Often times we look at something in our lives and classify it as only a "small" sin; however, it hinders us from being the Christian we ought to be. You see, when we carry things into our lives (or into the church) from the world outside, it will always hinder our lives from working smoothly in the Lord's Kingdom. Although they may only seem as "small" things, yet they can do great harm in our lives.

I could have just let that pebble lay there on my chair mat and ignored it. You know what would have happened; the next time I moved my chair, there it would have been again. When we realize there is something in our lives that ought not to be, as difficult as it may be to remove, we must do so! Perhaps this is what the writer of Hebrews was trying to get us to understand when he wrote, "...let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us" (Hebrews 12:1).

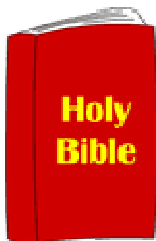

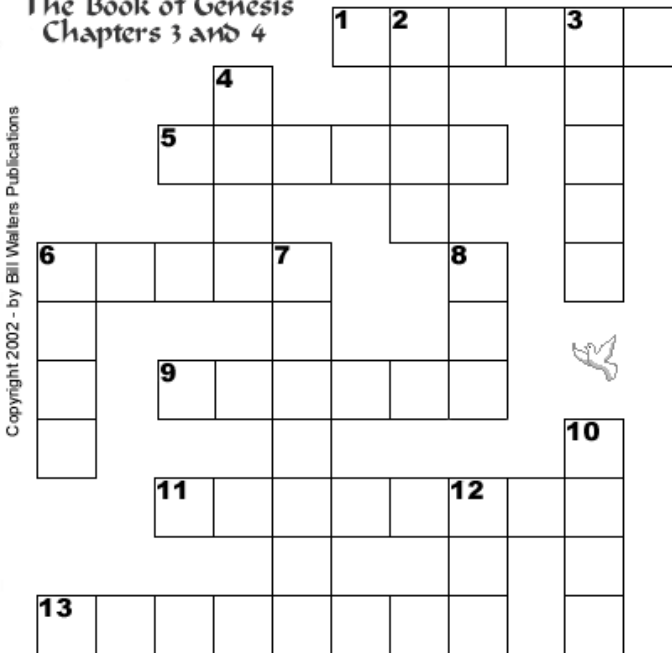
